Food in the Couch

Items needed: A sofa (or some other piece of furniture) 10 M&M's /Smarties/ Maltesers / or similar A straw A small bowl

Set up: Spread the sweets on top of the sofa

How to play:

The children have been eating in the living room again! In this challenge your task is to vacuum up the sweets on the sofa using only the straw and your lung power. Suck each sweet up with the straw and place it in the bowl. You have 60 seconds to complete the task.

<u>Cookie Face</u>

Items needed: One cookie or biscuit for each player

How to play:

Nothing tastes better than Mum's cooking! In this challenge, you have to move the cookie/ biscuit from your forehead to you mouth, using only your facial muscles to wiggle the cookie/ biscuit on its way. Complete the task in 60 seconds or less, or it's no treat for you!

Craft: Make a plant pot

You will need

Old Newspapers Water PVA Glue Wallpaper paste Clingfilm Mould e.g. Mug/ Bowl/ Small Vase Paint

Instructions

- 1. Tear up enough small pieces of newspaper to fill a mug when packed tight
- 2. Place the pieces of newspaper in a bowl and cover with hot water. Leave to soak for three hours
- 3. Transfer the soaked paper into a colander or sieve. Squeeze the pieces together so that the water runs out and the paper forms a mash
- 4. Put the mashed paper back into the empty bowl and add a tablespoon of pva glue and a tablespoon of wallpaper paste to the mixture.
- 5. Line the inside of your mould with clingfilm
- 6 Press paper pulp into the mould with your fingers. When it is about 1cm thick smooth the surface with your fingers.
- 7. Leave to dry for three hours
- 8. Once dry lift the pulp shell carefully out of the mould.
- 9 Paint the bowl in a colour of your choice
- 10.Your plant pot is now ready
