Liturgical

Each day is presented with the date, day and the Sunday Title or Saints/Feast Day taken from *The Church in Wales Lectionary* produced by The Church in Wales/Yr Eglwys yng Nghymru. If a minor Saint's day falls on a Sunday, then it is not observed, unless it is your church's Feast of Title or Dedication, in which case it may take precedence over a Sunday in Ordinary Time. Otherwise, it may be celebrated on the next available ferial day.

Group I and II Holy Days (those which should always be celebrated) are shown with **BOLD UPPERCASE LETTERS**. Group III Festivals and Commemorations (those with lectionary provision for the daily Eucharist and Offices), Group IV and V Festivals and Commemorations are shown with **lowercase bold letters**.
